The new student from Colombia wants to know all about your city! Describe in as much detail as possible all about you can about what there is to do/see around your city/state.

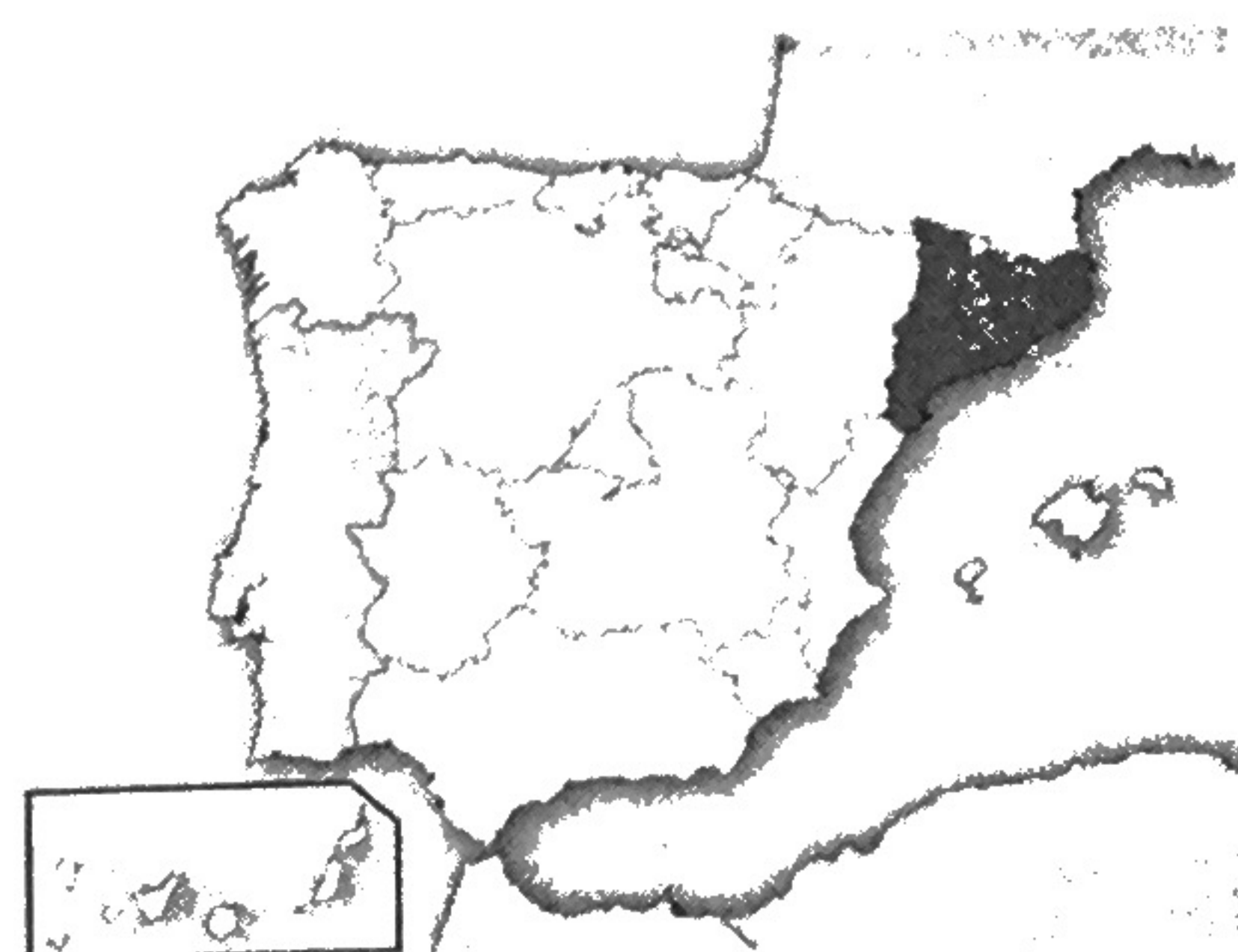
Novice Mid 16: I can talk about my daily activities using words, phrases, and memorized expressions.
